"A new commandment I give to you, that you love **one another**, even as I have loved you, that you also love **one another**.

John 13:35

"By this all men will know that you are My disciples, if you have love for **one another**."

Romans 2:21

Owe nothing to any**one** except to love **one another**; for he who loves his neighbor has fulfilled the law.

Romans 14:13

Therefore let us not judge **one another** anymore, but rather determine this--not to put an obstacle or a stumbling block in a brother's way.

Romans 14:19

So then we pursue the things which make for peace and the building up of **one another**.

Romans 15:5 -

Now may the God who gives perseverance and encouragement grant you to be of the same mind with **one another** according to Christ Jesus,

Romans 15:7

Therefore, accept **one another**, just as Christ also accepted us to the glory of God.

Romans 15:14

And concerning you, my brethren, I myself also am convinced that you yourselves are full of goodness, filled with all knowledge and able also to admonish **one another**.

1Corinthians 12:25

so that there may be no division in the body, but that the members may have the same care for **one another**

1Corinthians 16:20

All the brethren greet you. Greet **one another** with a holy kiss

2Corinthians 13:12

Greet **one another** with a holy kiss.

Galatians 5:13

For you were called to freedom, brethren; only do not turn your freedom into an opportunity for the flesh, but through love serve **one another**.

Galatians 5:15

But if you bite and devour **one another**, take care that you are not consumed by **one another**.

Galatians 5:26

Let us not become boastful, challenging **one another**, envying **one another**

Galatians 6:2

Bear **one another's** burdens, and thereby fulfill the law of Christ.

Galatians 6:4

But each **one** must examine his own work, and then he will have reason for boasting in regard to himself **alone**, and not in regard to **another**.

Eph 4:2

with all humility and gentleness, with patience, showing tolerance for **one another** in love,

Ephesians 4:25

Therefore, laying aside falsehood, SPEAK TRUTH EACH **ONE** of you WITH HIS NEIGHBOR, for we are members of **one another**.

Ephesians 4:32

Be kind to **one another**, tender-hearted, forgiving each other, just as God in Christ also has forgiven you.

Ephesians 5:19

speaking to **one another** in psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, singing and making melody with your heart to the Lord;

Ephesians 5:21 -

and be subject to **one another** in the fear of Christ.

Philippians 2:3

Do nothing from selfishness or empty conceit, but with humility of mind regard **one another** as more important than yourselves;

Colossians 3:9

Do not lie to **one another**, since you laid aside the old self with its evil practices,

Colossians 3:13

bearing with **one another**, and forgiving each other, whoever has a complaint against any**one**; just as the Lord forgave you, so also should you.

Colossians 3:16

Let the word of Christ richly dwell within you, with all wisdom teaching and admonishing **one another** with psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, singing with thankfulness in your hearts to God.

1Thessalonians 3:12

and may the Lord cause you to increase and abound in love for **one another**, and for all people, just as we also do for you;

1Thessalonians 4:9

Now as to the love of the brethren, you have no need for any**one** to write to you, for you yourselves are taught by God to love **one another**;

1Thessalonians 4:18

Therefore comfort **one another** with these words.

1Thessalonians 5:11

Therefore encourage **one another** and build up **one another**, just as you also are doing.

1Thessalonians 5:13

and that you esteem them very highly in love because of their work. Live in peace with **one another**.

1Thessalonians 5:15

See that no **one** repays **another** with evil for evil, but always seek after that which is good for **one another** and for all people.

2Thessalonians 1:3

We ought always to give thanks to God for you, brethren, as is only fitting, because your faith is greatly enlarged, and the love of each **one** of you toward **one another** grows ever greater

Hebrews 3:13

But encourage **one another** day after day, as long as it is still called "Today," so that **none** of you will be hardened by the deceitfulness of sin

Hebrews 10:24

and let us consider how to stimulate **one another** to love and good deeds,

Hebrews 10:25

not forsaking our own assembling together, as is the habit of some, but encouraging **one another**; and all the more as you see the day drawing near.

Jas 4:11

Do not speak against **one another**, brethren. He who speaks against a brother or judges his brother, speaks against the law and judges the law; but if you judge the law, you are not a doer of the law but a judge of it.

James 5:9

Do not complain, brethren, against **one another**, so that you yourselves may not be judged; behold, the Judge is standing right at the door.

James 5:16

Therefore, confess your sins to **one another**, and pray for **one another** so that you may be healed. The effective prayer of a righteous man can accomplish much.

1Peter 1:22

Since you have in obedience to the truth purified your souls for a sincere love of the brethren, fervently love **one another** from the heart,

1Peter 4:8

Above all, keep fervent in your love for **one another**, because love covers a multitude of sins.

1Peter 4:9

Be hospitable to **one another** without complaint.

1Peter 4:10

As each **one** has received a special gift, employ it in serving **one another** as good stewards of the manifold grace of God.

1Peter 5:5

You younger men, likewise, be subject to your elders; and all of you, clothe yourselves with humility toward **one another**, for GOD IS OPPOSED TO THE PROUD, BUT GIVES GRACE TO THE HUMBLE.

1Peter 5:14

Greet **one another** with a kiss of love. Peace be to you all who are in Christ.

1Jo 1:7

but if we walk in the Light as He Himself is in the Light, we have fellowship with **one another**, and the blood of Jesus His Son cleanses us from all sin.

1John 3:11

For this is the message which you have heard from the beginning, that we should love **one another**;

1John 3:23

This is His commandment, that we believe in the name of His Son Jesus Christ, and love **one another**, just as He commanded us.

1John 4:7

Beloved, let us love **one another**, for love is from God; and every**one** who loves is born of God and knows God.

1John 4:11

Beloved, if God so loved us, we also ought to love **one another**.

No **one** has seen God at any time; if we love **one another**, God abides in us, and His love is perfected in us.
